CHRISTIAN CAMPUS MINISTRY OF TERRE HAUTE REPORT FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

Last school year was the first in some time that began with no extra protocols on campus, and the change was significant. The new group that came in was ready to connect and get involved. We had several Freshmen that came in on mission for the Lord and led unofficially in several capacities. It was a very exciting kick off.

CSF held many of our typical ministry opportunities through the year. Sunday Morning Worship, Wednesday Night Bible Study, Small Groups and Retreats all continue to be core to the things that we do, as well as discipleship of students by staff and student leaders. In all of these we point to Jesus as Lord of our lives and equip these students for Kingdom work.



Fall Retreat is always a huge part of building community in our ministry. The tone of the semester always changes after retreat and this semester was no different. After a large group of our students spend the weekend together the sense of community and family always grows, and we shift from an intense connection

focus to mission focus as well. Connecting with new students and deepening friendships with veteran students is always a beautiful thing.



There were many high points of the year. We put more attention into tracking the way students were being discipled by other students and staff and were blown away to see that nearly 50 students were in those types of investing relationships! We also had an uptick of students and staff being able to have faith conversations with friends and students on campus that do not know Jesus yet. It was also a beautiful thing to see students jumping in and serving both in our ministry programs but also in the community at things like 14th and Chestnut or with our Fostering Hope connected "Parents Night Out".

I wrote this last year and it remains the same. There is so much need on our campuses. Students need Jesus. They need the hope that He brings and the life that He gives. Many students don't know who Jesus is or what Christianity is really about. On another level, mental strain and overwhelm is an epidemic in itself. The reasons are varying and complex, but on a daily basis we are engaging with students who have experienced trauma both past and recent, students who are crippled by anxiety, students who don't see much hope for a future, students that are jaded. We want

to walk alongside these students, to share life with them, and to show them the One that brings hope and joy and life into our existence.

CSF has been serving students in Terre Haute for 55 years! As we start up a new semester, please pray for us and with us. Please pray that students would come onto campus hungering for God. Please pray that students would be looking for community. Pray for students to develop a holy curiosity and seek out who Jesus is. Pray for followers of Jesus on campus to be involved in every corner of it; that there would be no student on campus that would not have a follower of Christ in their lives.

Please pray for us on staff. For wisdom and compassion as we love these students the best that we can. Pray that we can be models of what it looks like to follow Jesus fully.
